ENNIO MORRICONE

In 2020, our long-time supporter, **Maestro Ennio Morricone** was honoured for his lifetime achievements. The sold-out event, which took place at the elegant Théâtre du Vaudeville in Brussels, featured a heart-felt performance of the Maestro's most emotional pieces by an ensemble of his favourite musicians who had travelled especially from Rome for the concert.

An ECSA delegation personally handed over the award to Ennio Morricone in Rome. The audience in Brussels, comprised mostly of **composers, music lovers, and European Members of Parliament**, were unified in their praise of the evening.

SPONSOR THE AWARD STATUETTES

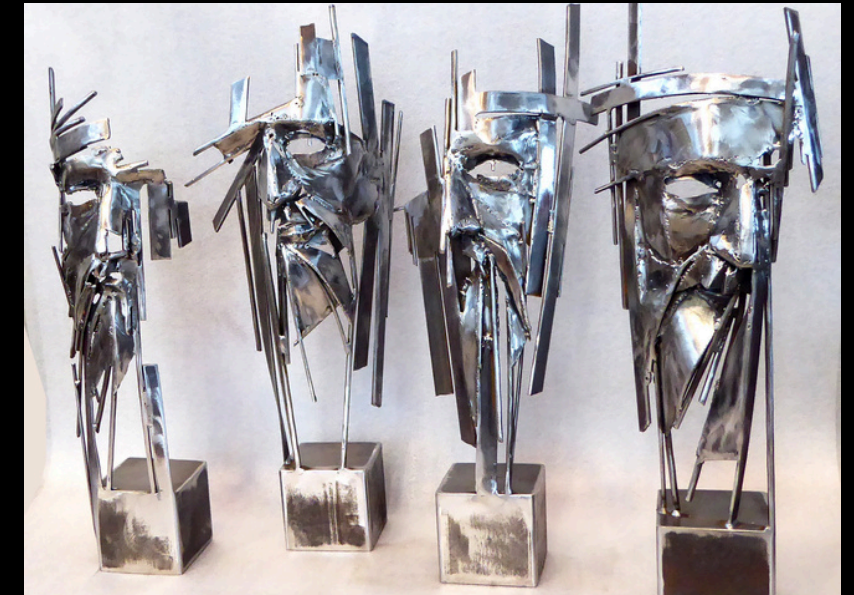
The iconic statuettes for the four awards (Best Film Score, Best Original Music for a Series, Best Score for a Feature Documentary, and Outstanding Contribution Award) are created by sculpture artist Caroline Brisset. The awards represent the contours of Camille Saint-Saëns, composer of the first music to be scored for a movie. Brisset's iconic statuettes have been part of the ceremony for years and are inseparably connected to the Camille Awards' image. For 10.000€, sponsorship of an award will include the presence of the brand's name on the statuette's plaque and in the title of the award.

SPONSOR THE CEREMONY'S REFRESHMENTS, FOOD, OR TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT
